Hobby-horse

The hobby-horse riding stick, a popular toy among children today, actually has its origins in antiquity. In ancient Greek it was known as "kalamon epivainein" (i.e. stick riding).

To create a hobby-horse, all one needed was a long stick or reed and plenty of imagination!



Materials

- Broomstick
- String or rope
- Glue
- Pencils
- Craft paper

Instructions

Using an A3 cardboard, draw the outline of a horse's head. Cut out the head and draw the details. You can use the string to create the horse's hair. Glue or tie the head to the broomstick and your hobby-horse is ready!
